From The Principal



I would like to take this opportunity to express on behalf of the school community our condolences to the Kinnear family for the tragic loss of their son Jared in a car accident. Jared attended Macksville High School completing year 12 in 2007. He represented the school on numerous occasions bringing credit to himself and his school. Macksville High School had the honour of hosting his funeral in the stadium. The outstanding number of people in attendance was a wonderful tribute to Jared and a celebration of his life.

It's a very busy time with junior exams underway, School Certificate exams completed this week and HSC quickly coming to an end. Last Friday we had an interesting day with the big wet, yet again. Buses went home early and Showtime had to be postponed at the last minute. We have decided to try again on Friday 20th November and give all the kids involved a chance to strut their stuff on the stage. We need your support on the night to ensure the evening is a success.

An important event coming up that I encourage Year 9 parents to attend is the meeting on Wednesday 18th November to introduce the Digital Education Revolution and the roll out of student laptops.

FREE SCHOOL TRAVEL—IS YOUR CHILD ELIGIBLE?

If your child is a NSW resident aged 4 years and 6 months or older, they are eligible for a free school travel pass if they are enrolled under one of the following conditions:

- An infant student (Years K-2)
- A primary student (Years 3-6) who lives outside a 1.6km radius from the school or subject to Ministry of Transport (MoT) approval, 2.3km or more by the most direct walking path to the school.
- A high school student who lives outside a 2km radius from the school or subject to MoT approval, 2.9km or more by the most direct walking path to the school.
- A student who is approved for free school travel on health or safety grounds by the MoT.
- The Busways School Travel Department (9497 1861) can advise you on your child's eligibility status.
- DID YOU KNOW? Students who are progressing to Year 3 or Year 7 need to reapply for their free school bus passes.
- Application forms are available from your school office. It needs to be filled out by the applying student's parent/ guardian and handed in to the school

Custom-made for school use, the laptops are robust, compact and lightweight, and fit easily in a school bag. They come fully loaded with a

range of leading software and learning applications.

The laptops are wireless enabled so students can connect to the school network and the internet in and around school grounds.

If you have the internet at home, your child can also connect to school and the internet from home.

Prior to any student receiving a laptop, parents, carers and students must sign a user charter and this will be available on the night along with a Digital Education Revolution support package.


