On the way home a call into Ricardoes Tomatoes to pick strawberries and to see how the tomatoes are grown was a load of fun.

We were amazed by the beautiful Indonesian dancers who performed in traditional costume for Port Macquarie High School, St Patrick's Primary School, Bowraville Central School and at the Macksville High School Assembly in front of our Mayor, Rhonda Hoban and special guests. They even took the time to teach the younger children how to use the rebana (tamborine drum) which they thoroughly enjoyed.

Several students spoke to me about their experience and described how their billet families made them feel so at home. They had a great time at the school social dancing the night away. How they did things that they had never experienced before like, roasting marshmallows on the beach, painting a rock at the V-Wall, horse riding, the great food including lamingtons, pasta dishes and chocolate cake, going to Woolworths shopping, feeding the horses, lambs and sheep, they said they loved everything.
