From our Principal

The Higher School Certificate is well underway. They are being held in the school stadium and in a local church hall. Students who have been involved in an incident leading up to an exam or are ill before or during an exam should let the exam supervisor know on entry to the exam and let me know as soon as possible. I would also like to take this opportunity to acknowledge the difficulties those families are having who have students sitting the HSC in bush fire affected areas. I look forward to catching up with students and their parents at the Graduation Formal to be held Macksville Ex-Services Club on the 14th November.

This week we have commenced a trial of "Bring Your Own Device" (BYOD) with one Year 7 and two Year 8 classes. This is about students bring their own computer device that will connect with the school system. With the demise of the Federal Government funded state laptop program this is the direction Department of Education and Communities is heading. The trial is to consider the implementation issues, identify concerns and look at how equity is to be maintained for all students. There has been a parent meeting, detailed information provided to the students and parents involved in the trial and teachers monitoring the trial. If you have any concerns or comments don't hesitate to contact me to discuss.

I would also like to remind parents and family members that the use of mobile phones at school is limited to break times. Students are told not to use their phone or answer a call during class time. This is at times made difficult when parents call their kids during these times. If you have an emergency you should contact the school office and have any messages passed on. The other option is to call between 10.50-11.10am and 12.50-1.30 pm.
